**Li Zhijian**

Li Zhijian is the Director General of Asia-pacific Innovation Economic Research Institute, a member of the Advisory Committee of the Service Industry of the National Development and Reform Commission, and a specialist of the “ Belt and Road ” Think Tank Cooperative Alliance led by the International Department of the Central Committee of the Communist Party of China, and the vice-chairman of Guangdong Federation of Social Sciences .

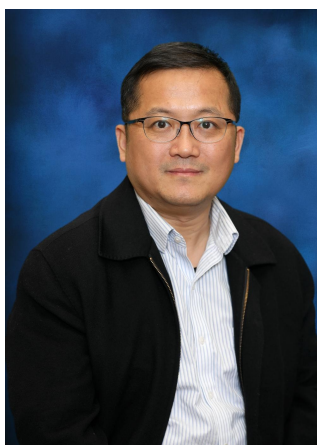
Mr. Liu mainly engaged in industrial economy and urban
